



## Reminders as we begin 2022 Elections:

- Positions are **1 year** terms. (Up to 4 consecutive yrs) 2021 Quorum was 9
- For voting we need simple majority of voters (½ + 1) to pass something.
- Need 3-5 **BOD** Members, since we need voting block to be odd (including ED) last year, **we elected 4, but had no ED.**
- Officer Positions are:
  - Chair 'general charge & supervision of affairs of BxCRRB'
  - Vice Chair -Duties of chair if chair can't
  - Secretary Documents/Notes/Files/Calendar Invites
  - Treasurer Money/Dues/Bank/Taxes
  - & Alternates
